YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL TRIP TO FRANCE – MAY 2020

Dear Year 6 parents and carers,

Following the success of this year and last, we are excited to share the details of next year's residential trip to France.

Dates: Monday 18th – Friday 22nd May 2020 inclusive (5 days; 4 nights)

Location: Normandy, France

Who: Year 6 pupils only

Cost: £360 per pupil

Our trip is being facilitated by Travelbound: a company who specialise in organising residential trips abroad for schools. The children will be accompanied on this trip by their Year 6 teachers and other Kelvin Grove staff members.

As part of our itinerary, the children will enjoy a number of rich cultural experiences including: a visit to Mont St Michel, Arromanches town (including the beach), a chocolate factory (including tasting!), shopping for ingredients at a traditional French market and then preparing lunch with that they've bought. They will also view the historic Bayeux Tapestry. As well as this, the children will have the invaluable opportunity to practise their spoken French and to use foreign currency. We will stay together in a beautiful historic house called Chateau du Molay. We will help to prepare the children for the trip through their curriculum French lessons in Year 6. **There are 60 places available – these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.** To help us keep track of when forms are returned we ask that you please return all slips directly to your child's Year 5 teacher (and not the school office) who will forward them on to us in Year 6.

We have arranged a meeting on **Monday 1st July at 5.15pm in the Paxton Hall** to tell you more about the trip. We highly encourage you to attend. If you are unable to attend this meeting but would like your child to come on the trip, please indicate this on the reply slip below. **After the meeting, if you wish to secure your child's place we require a non-refundable deposit of £40 to be paid by Friday 12th July.** In addition to ongoing correspondence, there will be two more meetings next academic year to provide further details about our trip. Please return the reply slip to your child's teacher at the latest by Monday 28th June.
