

Learning Intentions-Spring Term 2020

Personal, Social & Emotional

- To have a developing awareness of own needs, views and feelings and be sensitive to the needs, views of others;
- To understand what is right and wrong and why
- To be confident to try new activities and communicate with familiar group.

Physical

- To show respect for other children's personal space when playing among them
- To be able to use equipment with increasing control and with regard to safety of others
- Develop pencil grip

Communication & Language

- To show an understanding of the sequence of events of a story
- To begin to form recognisable letters
- Begin to retell a favourite traditional story

Understanding the World

- Develop simple map and route skills
- To talk about the changes they see in the environment.

Expressive Arts & Design

- To use their imagination in music
- Role play using available resources
- Explore and experience using a range of senses and movements

Mathematics

- To recognise groups with 1,2 or 3 objects or more if appropriate
- Write marks to represent numbers
- Sequence a range of objects/pictures

Literacy

- To listen to stories with increasing attention and recall
- Begin to predict what comes next
- Handle books with care
