

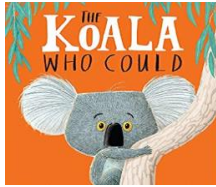

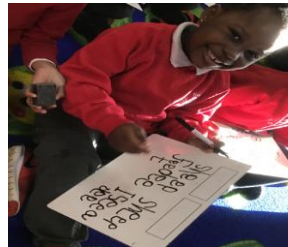
Literacy



We have been reading 'The Koala Who Could'. The story is set in Australia and explores how Kevin the koala, overcomes his fears of trying new things.

We have used adjectives in our writing this week. As well as focused on applying our phonics knowledge.

Phonics



We have continued with Phase 3 sounds this week.

We have learnt the digraphs and the trigraph (three letters making one sound):

ai, ee, oa, igh

Our focus has been deepening our understanding of the numbers 6, 7 and 8.

We have explored what these numbers look like, how we can make them using different objects, finding 1 more or 1 less and writing them.
