Dear Parents/Carers,

Further to last week's letter in response to the government's announcement, I wanted to give you an update on our plans for a potential phased return to school for Reception, Year 1 and Year 6. This return is from Monday 1st June at the earliest but please remember that this date is not yet confirmed and the government will be making further announcements. We know you will have questions about when your children will be able to return to Kelvin Grove and we are really looking forward to welcoming children and families back. Over the next couple of weeks, we will be making sure arrangements are in place so that all children and adults can be as safe as possible while they are here.

There are no plans for children in Years 2, 3, 4 & 5 to return before September as yet.

Only children of critical workers will be able to access any extended provision (breakfast and after school club). Proof of critical worker status will be required.

Between now and any phased reopening, only children of critical workers and those identified as vulnerable can come in to school with the agreement of the Headteacher.

Whilst planning for a phased reopening, it is our priority to ensure that children, staff and families are safe. We are using a range of protective measures to create safer environments to minimise risk, following government guidelines. As part of the phased return, the start date for groups of pupils will not be the same, even in the same year group. Once the date for schools re-opening is confirmed, we will contact families individually to let you know when your child can come in. **Children should only return to school when they have received a start date from us and not before.** We will tell you more as soon as we can.

In the meantime, home learning provision for all pupils will continue as normal.

Thank you so much for your continued support of the school during this difficult time.
