Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to thank all families for the positive feedback, kind comments and practical and moral support we have felt as a staff here at Kelvin Grove. Comments made to teachers whilst conducting wellbeing calls were overwhelmingly supportive of the school's approach and balance of home learning opportunities.

We are cautiously making a number of plans depending on how and when children return to school. It is important that we recognise at the moment that there is nothing but rumour on the news and no clear guidance as yet from the government. What we do know is it will not be a situation where schools return to normal overnight. It is likely that return to school will be phased, both for children and for staff, and issues such as social distancing and protecting the most vulnerable will remain in place for some time. During this phased return, the safeguarding and wellbeing of our pupils and families will be at the heart of everything we do.

I am confident in the quality of our staff at Kelvin Grove and their commitment to ensuring that no child falls behind as a result of being away from school – there will undoubtedly be the need for children to catch up in the core skills of reading, writing and maths. Our staff recognise the strengths and individuality of each child and will, as we always have done, personalise their learning within the class.

Over the next year, there will be a lot to do – but I know that as a Kelvin Grove community, we are committed to keeping children, families and staff safe whilst delivering the very best education possible.
