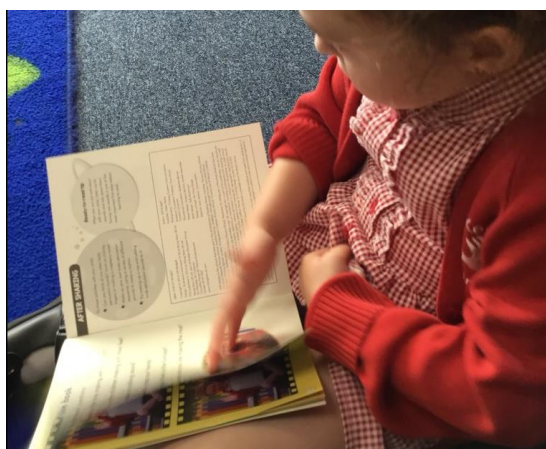


Reading books

Children will be bringing home a school reading book and reading record. We will change books weekly. In Week 4 your child's class teacher will share with you the day your child's book will be changed. Please try and read together for 15 minutes each day. We will write in the reading record when your child has read at school.

Please can you write in the reading record when you have read with your child too. When reading, try talking about the pictures, what might happen in the story, what new information you have found out and point to the words on the page.

Later this term we will be sending home other tips for how to help your child become a reader.



What your child needs each day:

- Red Kelvin Grove book bag with a change of clothes inside.
- Named water bottle (Not juice)

Please make sure that you put your child's name in everything they bring to school.

PE

Mr Djavit will be teaching PE every **Thursday**, from next week.

Children will need to come to school wearing their PE kit: white t-shirt, black jogging bottoms or shorts, plimsolls or trainers without laces (unless they can do their laces up!)
