

Expressive arts and design

- I will enjoy taking part in action songs
- I will be drawing and painting pictures of myself using mirrors
- I will drawing pictures of my family
- I will be thinking about colours and using them appropriately in my pictures
- I will be using a range of materials to make collages and models to express my ideas
- I will develop my pretend play, pretending that one object represents another.

Maths

- I am learning to complete puzzles independently

- I am learning to count daily - using the class number line. Talk about how many are here/not here today
- I am beginning to use mathematical language in my play. Using words like empty, full in water play. Counting out and sharing the toys with my friends.

- I will select resources independently
- I will be learning routines of the nursery session
- I will be creating class rules with my friends
- I will be learning and talking about my family and other people who are important to me
- I will be making lots of new friends
