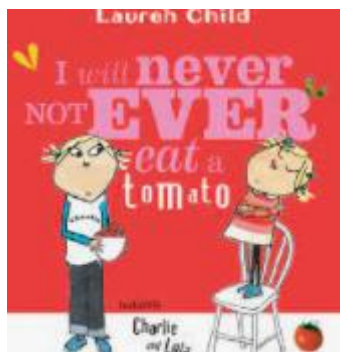

Phonics

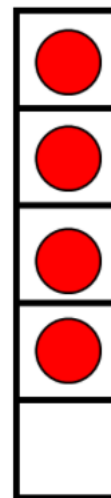
We use phonics (learning the sounds of the letters) as our method of teaching reading.

We also learnt to read and write the word "I" and 'go'.

Maths

We have been focusing on the number 5. We learnt different ways to represent the number and how to use a **five frame**.

Pe day is always Thursday. Please wear trainers and make sure you still wear your red /Kelvin Grove jumper.

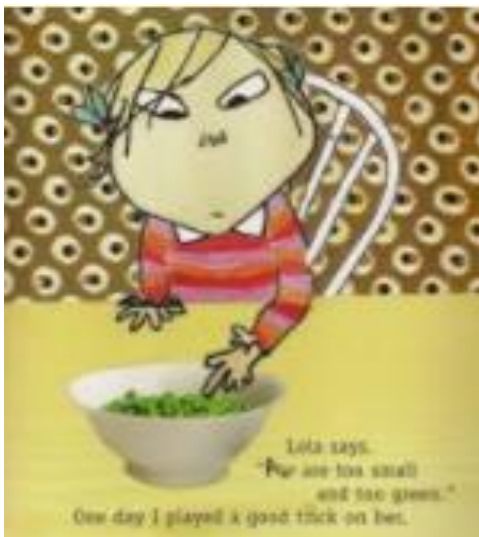
Book bags and reading books - Books are changed weekly but please have your child's reading record and their books every day.
