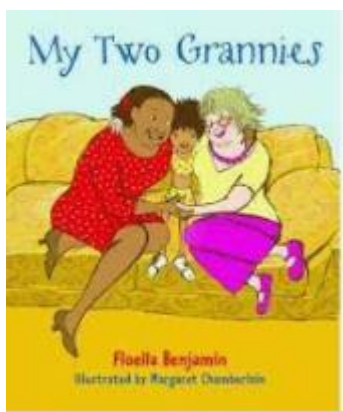

Literacy

This week we travelled to Trinidad and England to read 'My two Grannies'. Granny Rose is from England and Granny Veero is from Trinidad. We focused on England this week.



Phonics

We started learning some Phase 3 sounds this week to support us with our writing 'j, v, w, y z'.
