



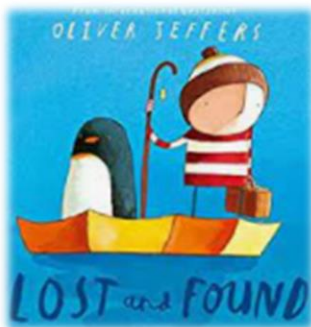

Literacy

We continued to read 'Lost and Found' which the children have really loved! We have learnt lots of facts about penguins and the Antarctica. We found out information about the weather, the animals that live there and what we can do to protect this special place.



Phonics



This week we have continued to revise our phase 2 phonics. We have been writing words, phrases and sentences. It is amazing how much progress all of the children have made. We are very proud of all the children have achieved.

Maths

It has been such a fun week learning all about positional language. We have been using the dolls house to place dolls 'in the bath' and 'under the table'.

We have used positional language to describe where things are placed, such as 'the monkey is in between' and 'the monkey is on top of your head'.



Home Talk

Can you and your child discuss the south pole? Which animals live there? DO any humans live there? What do the animals eat? How can we help look after this habitat?
