This week in English we have continued to learn about instructions. In Moths, we have been learning and consolidating our understanding of the place value of a two-digit number. We have been learning to add and subtract multiples of ten from a 2-digit number. We used hundred squares to look at what happens to the tens and ones when we add multiples of ten. We then used our knowledge to answer addition and subtraction sums in our books.
