English learning this week



This week we have been using our taught tricky words 'I' 'is' and 'the' in our writing.

We have begun to practise writing each sound in our handwriting session.

In our daily phonics lesson, we are blending words with our taught sounds. Some of us have begun to use our new sounds in our reading practise books.

Maths learning this week



It has been a very fun and practical week in maths. We have focused on the key vocabulary 'more, fewer and same'.

We have explored different ways to work out if 2 groups have more, fewer or the same quality.

We used counting, subitising (Subitising is when you are able to look at a group of objects and realise how many there are without counting) and five frames.

Our learning next week

We will be focusing on the season of Autumn.

We hope to go on an autumn walk to our school forest school. We will use what we see, hear and collect to create our own poems.

We will continue to explore the concept of more and less in maths.

In phonics we will be revising the sounds we have already learnt and assessing the children's knowledge.
