

English learning this week

This week we have been learning the poem 'The Autumn Leaves.' The children have learnt the poem using actions and have enjoyed performing to their peers.

In our focus groups, we have looked at the signs of autumn and written the initial sounds for pumpkin, leaves, conkers, pinecones and the colours we could see.



Phonics learning this week

This week we have focussed on the graphemes 'h, b, f and l.' We have learnt the tricky words 'the' and consolidated 'I' and 'is.' The children have begun writing simple CVC words using taught graphemes.



Maths learning this week

This week we have been focusing on comparing numbers to 5 in two groups using irregular objects. We

have been using the key vocabulary 'less' and 'more' and 'equal.'



Name writing

This week the children have been learning to write their names correctly. Please help your child learn to write their name using a capital letter at the start, followed by all lower case letters.
