These are the digraphs and trigraphs that the children have found it tricky to remember.


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You can write them down, write them in the sand at the park, try and spot them in words at the shops!



Maths learning this week


This week in Maths, we have enjoyed using part part whole models to explore how we can partition numbers. The children have enjoyed looking at how many different ways a number can be partitioned.
