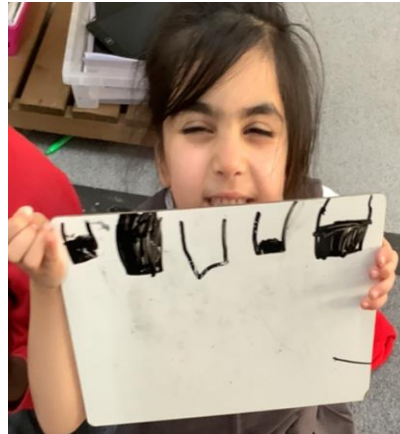


Maths learning this week

Summer Weather!

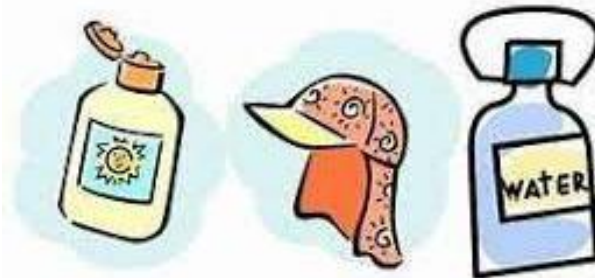
As the weather is getting warmer please ensure your child is ready for the hot school day.
