Primary Concerns: MP answers questions from students at KG

On Friday, Ellie Reeves came to visit our school. Ellie Reeves is the Labour MP for Lewisham West and East Dulwich, and has been an MP since 8 June 2017. She currently holds the Government post of Minister without Portfolio (Cabinet Office).

A group of Kelvin Grove children interviewed her to find out a bit more about who she is and how she can help children in education.



I know that you are a minister without portfolio, what exactly does that mean? Neriah (Year 4)

Ellie Reeves said that 'minister without portfolio' means she doesn't have a particular department that she works for. Instead she oversees lots of different areas like education, the police, health and transport. She is responsible for making sure everyone is doing their job properly.

Have you every travelled to different countries and met any other world leaders? Who is your favourite leader and why? Sheymahri (Year 4)

She hasn't been abroad in her job as minister. All of her work has been in the local area as this is her most important focus. She has met the King and Prince William though! He asked her what constituency she works for and what it was like working in government.

How long did it take you to study? How do you become a member of parliament? Zainab (Year 6)

You don't have to go to university to be a member of parliament. This is what makes parliament work so well –it is made up of people who are all different. Ellie Reeves studied for 5 years to become a lawyer and she worked as a lawyer for 12 years before taking on this job.

What is it like working for the government? Enyo (Year 6)

Ellie Reeves said it is a lot of hard work. It is important to know exactly what needs to be done to make improvements. For example, how can we make it easier for people to get a hospital appointment? How can we get more police on the streets? It takes a lot time and work to make these things possible.

n school council we have been talking about how dangerous the road can be at the end of Kelvin Grove. What could you do to help us make it safer for children? Ephraim (Year 5)

*Ellie explained that she would write a letter to Lewisham Council to find out what can be done. Ni'Mari asked if everyone in Lewisham Council has to agree with her if she writes a letter. Ellie said that they **have** to respond but they don't have to necessarily all agree!*

If you could change one thing about this country what would it be? Aine (Year 5)

"I believe every young person deserves the same opportunity" – Ellie went on to say that what she would change was more money for schools to support children's education, and also support for very young children to give them the very best start in life before school.

We have four school values at Kelvin Grove: compassion, health and well-being, building community and self-improvement. If you had to pick one of those values – which you consider the most important in your job? - Charlie B (Year 6)

"All of these values are very important." Ellie Reeves said that, if she had to pick one, she would pick building community – it is important to have strong local links and work well together. She said she could see that we have a strong community here at Kelvin Grove.

Our school is a special place because we have a lot of children with needs. What could the government do to help make schools like ours even better places for all students? Ni'Mari (Year 6)

Ellie made links to her answer to Aine's question – saying that it is part of her job to make sure schools get the money they need to be able to provide resources which help children get the very best education. She added that it was a priority to make sure children with special educational needs are well supported.

At the end, Ellie asked the children what they liked best about school! They all named their favourite subjects and Ni'Mari quickly asked her if she would help us improve our playground. Ellie said that was most definitely a job for our wonderful school council!

It was wonderful to meet her and all the children did a fantastic job!



A sugary DECLINE

Sugar gliders are enchanting animals. They're small, furry and ADORABLE. However, they are endangered. So, come with me on a journey to save these cute critters and learn why giving up space in your home and saving some money could help...



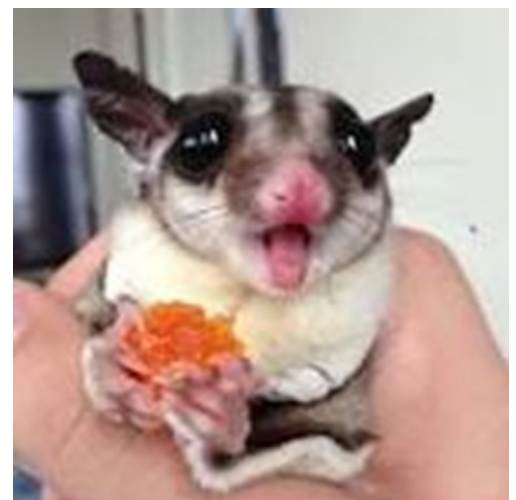
Sugar gliders are nocturnal creatures that live in groups. They mostly live in tree canopies. Wild ones normally live in woodlands located in New South Wales, Victoria, South Australia and Queensland with lots of eucalyptus trees

These creatures are omnivores. They eat foods like eucalyptus leaves, acacia trees, sap, nectar, pollen, insects - and sometimes even lizards and small birds! A whole sugar glider family can eat 200kg of insects. That is a lot for such tiny animals.

They are DEFINITELY marsupials and NOT rodents. You might have noticed from the picture they look a lot like possums but they are not. Why, I might say. Well it's because there is a special membrane (or skin) connected between their wrists and their ankles that allows them to glide. By the way, Sugar gliders are called that because they like sweet stuff like nectar and they can glide!

Wild sugar gliders live for 3-7 years; however, the captive sugar glider lives for 12-15 years. These adorable animals make a 'yip yip' sound to alert other sugar gliders of danger. For all we know, they could have a whole language. They also have a special skill called 'torpor', which means they can slow their breathing and reduce their body temperature for weeks. In torpor, sugar gliders wrap into a ball as body temperature drops, helping them save energy and stay alive through colder months with less food.

Now, you've learned enough about these animals, and you have probably realized that. Getting them as pets and breeding them will help them save their kind (let's just say they're not good hiders). Let me tell you how...

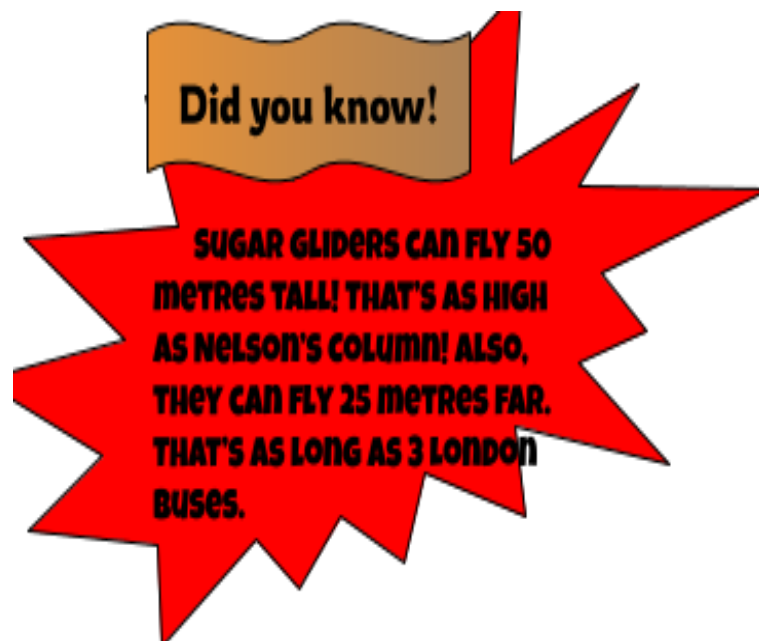


The TOP 9 Tips to Keeping Sugar Gliders

1. They need a large cage about *91.50x 61 x 101cm* It should have: lots of vertical space for jumping and climbing and include branches, perches and nest boxes
2. Keep them in a warm room between 24-27°C away from direct sunlight and air conditioning
3. Sugar gliders are social animals and shouldn't be kept alone. If you plan on buying one then ALWAYS get another.
4. They have specific nutrition needs, and should eat a balance of glider food fruit and veg and protein. Also give them insects as a special treat.
5. Trim nails regularly
6. NO COLLARS
7. Clean cage once a week to prevent illness
8. When you get new one, after you touch give treat so it associates you with good stuff
9. They need tall cages so they can exercise

They need one to two hours of playtime, preferably late.

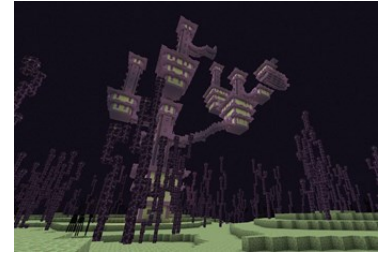
Once they had made about 50, they started selling. The next day, Marci went to Margot's house and they set up a stall in front. On the first day they made £21 and sold everything they had made.

Super Stars!

Hello readers! Today I'll be taking you through the fascinating world of Star Spectrums.



Y type stars

Y type stars are the coolest type of brown dwarfs, with temperatures from 200-500K! This doesn't mean they are suitable though. You would die of pressure as it would smooch you flat.

T type stars

A bit hotter, but still VERY hot, T type stars are 700-1300K. It doesn't mean They're Talkative, but They have some Treacherous Tricks! Not many of them have been discovered, though.

L type stars

These type of stars are the hottest of brown dwarfs, which are 1300-2400K! They aren't hot enough to make nuclear fusion in their cores, so you can just say they are VERY BIG, hot Jupiters. VERY BIG.

M type stars

The coolest main sequence stars, M type stars are 2,300-3,900K, with the nearest one being Proxima Centauri. Proxima Centauri is 4.2 light years away. That is actually VERY far.

K type stars

With temperatures from 3900-5300K, K type stars are quite cool compared to other stars, but you would be fried to a crisp if you even came NEAR IT. And you would literally evaporate.

G type stars

Ah, our lovely sun. The star that gives us warmth. From 5300-6000K, some stars aren't so lovely, like Rho Cassiopeia, a yellow hypergiant star which is bound to set off a supernova soon.

F type stars

F type stars are more white than yellow, from 6000-7400K. If an F type star replaced our sun, we would probably have to move to Mars. Or Jupiter. Or possibly Saturn.

A type stars

From 7600-10000K, A type stars like Vega are very hot, hence the reason why they are white coloured. I would not want to see an A type star in my bedroom.

B type stars

We're gettin' real hot with the stars now. B type stars have temperatures from 10000-30000K. The best known one is Rigel which (and trust me on this) is only 10 MILLION YEARS OLD compared to our sun.

O type stars

The hottest main sequence stars, O type stars are 25000-50000K. We would have to move 100-1000 times further away to withstand its temperature. Otherwise, we would get swallowed by it.
