### English and maths learning this week

We have explored the world through the books we have been reading this half term. We explored the warm waters of Trinidad, the chilly coast line of England and moved to the colder climate of the Arctic .

We have read Betty and the Yeti this week. The class have focused on list writing and revising our phase 2 phonic sounds. It is amazing to see how the children are applying their phonics and tricky word knowledge in their writing.



In maths, we have focused on adding 1 more and finding 1 less. The children have focused on orally sharing their answer and recording their ideas in a variety of ways.

We have introduced the children to number bonds to 5 and using the part, part, whole strategy. They have really understood the concept and are finding different ways to make the number 5.

### Phonics and Reading

The children have now learnt all the phase 2 sounds and tricky words. We will assess the children's knowledge this week.

We will use the information to support choosing your child's reading book. **Our reading groups are always flexible. You may notice that your child may have a book they have already read before, or may read the same book two weeks in a row, this is to continue to support their progress.**



We will not be sending home reading books this week. This will mean we can fully take stock and get ready for the new year.
