



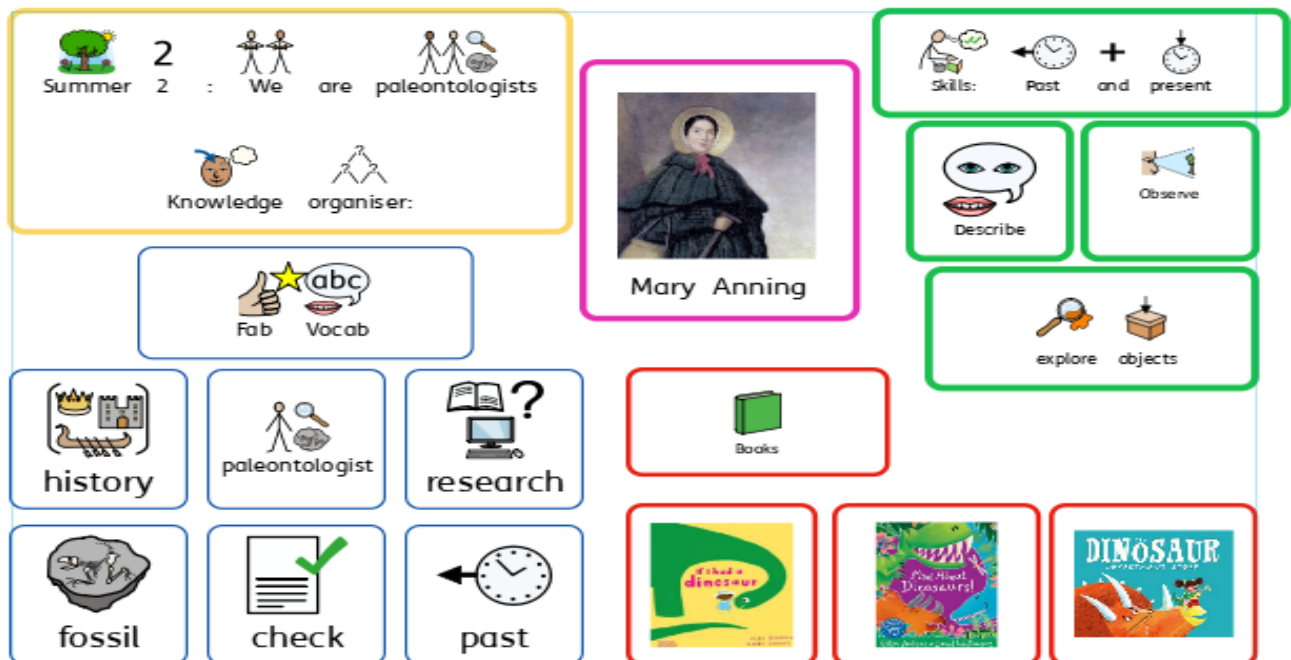
Friday 5th June 2026
